Granite United Way recognizes the importance of partnerships across community. We work with nonprofit partners, businesses and government to ensure the needs of our community are addressed.

This work looks different every day. A great example of collaboration is a nonprofit partner that came through our equity funding, Building Community in New Hampshire (BCNH.) Their organization helps refugees and other immigrants navigate their way to safe, healthy, prosperous, productive, and connected lives in New Hampshire. Their efforts build strong and diverse communities across our state.



By partnering with Granite United Way, Building Community in New Hampshire was able to support individuals and families in true grass-roots, community-driven ways. When the National Association of Women in Construction, Granite State Chapter collected toys to donate during the holidays, Granite United Way connected them to BCNH and the children they serve. In the colder season, they were able to work together to distribute warm winter coats that were donated through Granite United Way during the iHeart Media Coats for Kids drive. To meet its Community Reinvestment Act goals, BankProv invested \$5,000 in BCNH, thanks to our partners at GUW who knew that we would use it to help New Americans rebuild their lives. The connections and impact continue.
